(c) forest practices. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to require the avoidance of steep and erosive slopes, to specify seasons of operations, prevent weeds, require the use of best management practices, and to protect soils, wildlife, and fisheries.

(d) community traffic and safety. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to allow communities to control hours of operation, address traffic and school safety issues, and require road maintenance issues.

(e) weed prevention. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to require preventative measures for agencies to apply in permitting or other state actions.

(f) state parks and fishing access sites. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to protect adjacent property owners, address weed prevention, and establish standards for site planning.

(g) soil protection. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available that require the use of best management practices to avoid steep slopes or highly erosive soils.

(h) hard rock mining impacts. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are revised to include all major mines under the metal mine reclamation act so community impacts on schools, police, fire prevention, and infrastructure may be addressed.

(i) open-cut mines. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to control lighting, prevent weeds, and control the hours of operation.

(j) Montana water uses. A permit or other authority to act may be withheld, denied, or conditioned until statutory provisions are available to require that a permit is necessary to dewater streams for highway projects, mines, or other purposes in order to avoid impacts on existing water rights."
