(a) owns, is contracting to purchase, or is leasing for agricultural purposes at least 1,800 acres or more of privately owned land, some of which is used by elk, and who claimed at least \$5,000 in gross income for agricultural purposes on an appropriate internal revenue service form for the most recent year; and

(b) enters into a contractual public hunting access agreement with the department.

(2) A permit issued pursuant to subsection (1) is valid only in the hunting districts containing land that qualified the landowner to receive the permit.

(3) A permit issued pursuant to subsection (1) may be issued to:

(a) the qualifying landowner or lessee;

(b) a designated family member; or

(c) a bona fide employee of the qualifying landowner who pays taxes on farm or ranch employment income.

(4) A person who is issued a permit pursuant to subsection (1) is ineligible to participate in any other special drawing for an elk license or permit during that license year.

(5) As used in this section:

(a) "appropriate internal revenue service form" means the internal revenue service form necessary for an individual, partnership, or corporation to claim tax consideration for income that is considered agricultural income for tax purposes; and

(b) "contractual public hunting access agreement" means a signed agreement between the department and a landowner specifying how public hunting access will be administered on property owned by or under the legal control of the landowner.

The agreement may include but is not limited to designation of:

(i) the number of hunters and hunting days;

(ii) time periods of allowable public hunting;

(iii) property on which public hunting will be allowed;

(iv) the manner in which public hunters will be allowed access to the property; and

(v) rules explaining how hunting activities will be controlled or regulated on the property, such as travel management, game retrieval, landowner notification, and postseason reporting.

(6) The department shall report to the 58th legislature the number of hunting days used and permits issued pursuant to this section in each administrative region."
