## HOUSE BILL NO. 46

## INTRODUCED BY D. HAINES

## BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING TO \$40 MILLION THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE AND SELL GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE STATE'S SHARE OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL STATE REVOLVING FUND PROGRAM; INCREASING TO \$30 MILLION THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE AND SELL GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE STATE'S SHARE OF THE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF STATE DEBT; AMENDING SECTIONS 75-5-1122 AND 75-6-227, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 75-5-1122, MCA, is amended to read:

**"75-5-1122. Creation of debt.** The legislature, through the enactment of this law by a two-thirds vote of the members of each house, authorizes the creation of state debt in an amount not to exceed \$30 \$40 million and the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds in this amount for the purpose of providing the state's share of the program."

Section 2. Section 75-6-227, MCA, is amended to read:

**"75-6-227. Creation of debt.** The legislature, through enactment of this section, authorizes the creation of state debt in an amount not to exceed \$20 \$30 million and authorizes the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds in this amount for the purpose of providing the state's share of the drinking water program."

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Two-thirds vote required. Because [sections 1 and 2] authorize the creation of state debt, Article VIII, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires a vote of two-thirds of the members of each house of the legislature for passage.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2003.

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
