HOUSE BILL NO. 137 INTRODUCED BY M. LANGE BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH, WILDLIFE, AND PARKS

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REPEALING THE TERMINATION DATE FOR THE REQUIREMENT THAT AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF FISHING LICENSE FUNDS ALLOCATED FOR FISHING ACCESS SITES AND STREAM, RIVER, AND LAKE FRONTAGES BE USED FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AND BE PRIORITIZED AND EXPENDED FOR WEED MANAGEMENT, STREAMBANK RESTORATION, AND GENERAL OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4, CHAPTER 428, LAWS OF 1995, AND SECTION 1, CHAPTER 109, LAWS OF 1999; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Repealer. Section 4, Chapter 428, Laws of 1995, and section 1, Chapter 109, Laws of 1999, are repealed.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
