BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Repealer. Section 4, Chapter 428, Laws of 1995, and section 1, Chapter 109, Laws of 1999, are repealed.

Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
