## HOUSE BILL NO. 237

## INTRODUCED BY BRUEGGEMAN, WANZENRIED

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPPED WITH AN ENGINE COMPRESSION BRAKE DEVICE TO HAVE A MUFFLER; <u>ALLOWING USE OF AN ENGINE COMPRESSION</u> <u>BRAKE DEVICE EQUIPPED WITH A MUFFLER;</u> <del>AND</del> PROVIDING A PENALTY; <u>AND PROVIDING A DELAYED</u> <u>APPLICABILITY DATE.</u>"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Engine compression brake device <u>-- USE.</u> (1) A <u>COMMERCIAL</u> motor vehicle. <u>AS DEFINED IN 61-1-134</u>, equipped with an engine compression brake device must be equipped with a muffler in good working condition to prevent excessive noise.

(2) AN OPERATOR OF A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE THAT HAS AN ENGINE COMPRESSION BRAKE DEVICE WITH A FACTORY-INSTALLED MUFFLER OR AN EQUIVALENT AFTER-MARKET MUFFLER MAY NOT BE PROHIBITED FROM USING THE ENGINE COMPRESSION BRAKE DEVICE.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Violation of engine compression brake device provisions. A person who violates the provisions of [section 1] is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not to exceed \$500.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Codification instruction. (1) [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61, chapter 9, part 3, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 9, part 3, apply to [section 1].

(2) [Section 2] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61, chapter 9, part 5, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 9, part 5, apply to [section 2].

NEW SECTION. Section 4. APPLICABILITY. [SECTION 2] APPLIES TO VIOLATIONS OCCURRING ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2004.
