## HOUSE BILL NO. 299

## INTRODUCED BY PETERSON, BALES, BARRETT, RIPLEY, TASH

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT LIMITING THE LIABILITY OF OWNERS OF STOCK FOR TRESPASS TO INSTANCES OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE AND INTENTIONAL MISCONDUCT; CLARIFYING THAT HERD DISTRICT LAW APPLIES TO TRESPASSING ANIMALS IN HERD DISTRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 81-4-215, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

## Section 1. Section 81-4-215, MCA, is amended to read:

**"81-4-215. Liability of owners of stock for trespass.** If any cattle, horses, mules, asses, hogs, sheep, llamas, alpacas, bison, or other domestic animals break into any enclosure and the fence of the enclosure is legal, as provided in 81-4-101, the owner of the animals is <u>MAY BE</u> IS liable for all damages to the owner or occupant of the enclosure if the owner or person in control of the animals was grossly negligent or engaged in <u>intentional misconduct</u>. This section may not be construed to require a legal fence in order to maintain an action for injury done by animals running at large contrary to law. <u>IN THE CASE OF TRESPASSING ANIMALS IN A HERD</u> <u>DISTRICT, THE LIABILITY AND DAMAGE PROVISIONS OF 81-4-307 APPLY.</u>"

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to actions brought on or after [the effective date of this act].
