

HOUSE BILL NO. 435

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CLARIFYING THAT A LEGISLATOR MAY NOT ACCEPT A FEE OR CERTAIN OTHER COMPENSATION FOR SPEAKING TO A MONTANA STATE AGENCY OR ~~LOCAL GOVERNMENT~~ POLITICAL SUBDIVISION; AMENDING SECTION 2-2-111, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-2-111, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-2-111. Rules of conduct for legislators. Proof of commission of any act enumerated in this section is proof that the legislator committing the act has breached the legislator's public duty. A legislator may not:

(1) accept a fee, contingent fee, or any other compensation, except the official compensation provided by statute, for promoting or opposing the passage of legislation;

(2) seek other employment for the legislator or solicit a contract for the legislator's services by the use of the office; or

(3) ~~accept a fee for speaking to~~ OR OTHER COMPENSATION, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED FOR IN 5-2-302, FROM a MONTANA state agency or local government A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF MONTANA FOR SPEAKING TO THE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
