HOUSE BILL NO. 480
INTRODUCED BY STEINBEISSER, LAWSON, B. OLSON, ROME, SMITH, STOKER

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-7-118, MCA."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-7-118, MCA, is amended to read:
"61-7-118. Penalty for violation. (1) A person violating any provision of 61-7-104 through 61-7-110 or 61-7-112 through 61-7-114 is guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon a first convietion, the offender shall be punished by a fine of not less than $\$ 10 \$ 200$ or more than $\$ 100 \$ 300$ or by imprisonment for not more than $10 \underline{20}$ days. For a second convietion within 1 year thereafter of the first conviction, the offender shall be punished by a fine of not less than $\$ 25 \$ 300$ or more than $\$ 200 \$ 400$, or by imprisonment for not more than 2030 days ${ }_{2}$ or by both such fine-and imprisonment. Upon a third or subsequent convietion within 1 year of the first convietion, an effender shall be punished by a fine of not less than $\$ 50 \$ 400$ or more than $\$ 500$ or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
(1) A PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF 61-7-107 THROUGH 61-7-110 OR 61-7-112 THROUGH 61-7-114 IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR. UPON A FIRST CONVICTION, THE OFFENDER SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN $\$ 10$ OR MORE THAN $\$ 100$ OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 DAYS. FOR A SECOND CONVICTION WITHIN 1 YEAR THEREAFTER, THE OFFENDER SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$25 OR MORE THAN \$200 OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 DAYS, OR BY BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT. UPON A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION WITHIN 1 YEAR OF THE FIRST CONVICTION, AN OFFENDER SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50 OR MORE THAN \$500 OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS, OR BY BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.
(2) A PERSON CONVICTED UNDER 61-7-104 THROUGH 61-7-106 SHALL BE FINED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500 OR BE IMPRISONED FOR NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS, OR BOTH.
$(2)(3)$ Subject to the limitations of 46-18-231(3), an offender who fails to pay a fine shall be imprisoned in the county jail in the county in which the offense was committed, and the punishment shall be commuted at the rate of 1 day's incarceration for each $\$ 10 \$ 20$ of the fine."
