## HOUSE BILL NO. 685

## INTRODUCED BY MENDENHALL

## A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO COUNT STUDENTS IN A <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY--</u>RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER <u>CERTAIN FACILITY</u> IN THE DISTRICT'S ANB COUNT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AN <u>APPLICABILITY DATE</u>, AND A TERMINATION DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. ANB for students in certain facilities. A school district with a <u>CHILD-CARE</u> <u>AGENCY--residential treatment center FACILITY</u> for school-aged children located within the district's boundaries may include a student in the treatment center in the district's <u>ANB</u> <u>ENROLLMENT</u> count <u>A STUDENT WHO IS UNDER THE</u> <u>PROTECTIVE CARE OF A STATE AGENCY OR HAS BEEN ADJUDICATED BY A MONTANA COURT TO BE A YOUTH IN NEED OF</u> <u>INTERVENTION OR A DELINQUENT YOUTH, AS DEFINED IN 41-5-103, OR A STUDENT WHO IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL</u> <u>OUTSIDE OF THE DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE AS THE RESULT OF A PLACEMENT IN FOSTER CARE OR IN A GROUP HOME</u> <u>LICENSED BY THE STATE</u> if:

(1) THE CHILD-CARE AGENCY--RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER FACILITY IS LICENSED BY THE STATE AS A YOUTH GROUP HOME THAT PROVIDES THERAPEUTIC SERVICES;

(1)(2) the district retains written verification from the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY--</u>residential treatment center <u>FACILITY</u> documenting the student's participation in the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY--RESIDENTIAL</u> treatment center's <u>FACILITY's</u> education program on the date that enrollment is counted;

(2)(3) the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY--</u>residential treatment center has applied for accreditation for its education program from the board of public education;

(3)(4)(3) all of the teachers in the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY--</u>residential treatment center's <u>FACILITY'S</u> education program are certified, as provided in 20-4-101; <u>AND</u>

(4) the residential treatment center is licensed by the state as a youth group home that provides therapeutic services; and

(5)(4) the school district has entered into a contractual agreement with the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY</u> --residential treatment center <u>FACILITY</u> to provide educational services to the students in the center.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an

integral part of Title 20, chapter 9, part 3, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 9, part 3, apply to [section 1].

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Effective date -- applicability. [This act] is effective July 1, 2003, <u>AND</u> APPLIES TO SCHOOL BUDGETS FOR SCHOOL FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2003.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30, 2005.

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
