SENATE BILL NO. 212 INTRODUCED BY S. KITZENBERG

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A SECOND SCHOOL DISTRICT MILL LEVY ELECTION IN 1 YEAR IF LEGISLATIVE CHANGES ARE MADE TO SCHOOL FUNDING DURING THE CURRENT SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR; AMENDING SECTION 20-20-105, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-20-105, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-20-105. Regular school election day and special school elections -- limitation -- exception.

(1) The first Tuesday after the first Monday of May of each year is the regular school election day. Except as provided in subsection subsections (3) and (4), a proposition requesting additional funding under 20-9-353 may be submitted to the electors only once each calendar year on the regular school election day.

- (2) Subject to the provisions of subsection (1), special school elections may be conducted at times determined by the trustees.
- (3) In the event of an unforeseen emergency occurring on the date scheduled for the funding election pursuant to subsection (1), the district will be allowed to reschedule the election for a different day of the calendar year. As used in this section, "unforeseen emergency" has the meaning provided in 20-3-322(5).
- (4) The trustees of a school district may submit to the electors a proposition requesting additional funding under 20-9-353 if:
- (a) the legislature meets in special session and makes changes to the funding a school district will receive for the current school fiscal year; and
 - (b) the change in funding occurs after the regular school election held pursuant to subsection (1)."

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
