

SENATE BILL NO. 334  
INTRODUCED BY M. SPRAGUE

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES WHO MAY BE HIRED BY A VENDOR PROMOTING THE VENDOR'S PRODUCT IN THE STATE; REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT A POSITION BE FILLED WITHIN 60 DAYS OF A REPRESENTATIVE POSITION BEING VACATED; AND AMENDING SECTION 16-3-107, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 16-3-107, MCA, is amended to read:

**"16-3-107. Resident representatives required.** (1) For the purposes of this section, "vendor" means a person, partnership, association, or corporation that sells liquor to the department.

(2) A vendor who desires to promote the sale of ~~his~~ the vendor's product in the state shall employ one representative and may employ ~~an~~ two additional ~~representative~~ representatives to promote the sale of the vendor's product. A representative must be ~~or become after employment~~ a resident of the state or become a resident after employment. ~~If a vacancy occurs in a representative position, the vendor shall fill the position within 60 days after the vacancy occurs.~~"
