Dear Speaker Matthews and President Tester:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, I hereby return with amendments House Bill 266, "**AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE NOXIOUS WEED MANAGEMENT TRUST FUND CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT; AMENDING SECTIONS 60-3-201, 80-7-508, 80-7-801, 80-7-811, 80-7-814, AND 80-7-815, MCA; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES**" for the following reasons.

House Bill 266 implements the constitutional amendment establishing the noxious weed management trust fund, passed by the voters in November of 2004. My proposed amendments make no substantive changes to the bill. Rather, the amendments accomplish two things. First, they clarify that interest or revenue generated by the trust fund must be expended only on noxious weed management projects, as provided in the voter-passed constitutional amendment. Second, they correct certain internal subsection references misnumbered in the drafting process.

I have discussed my proposed amendment with the sponsor of the bill, Representative Diane Rice, and with Nancy Peterson, Director of the Montana Department of Agriculture. Both individuals support the amendment. The proposed amendment is attached to this letter.
