A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA AND  
GOVERNOR BRIAN SCHWEITZER

RECOGNIZING THE RUNNING ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF SCOTT MCGOWAN

WHEREAS, Scott McGowan, a native of Poplar, Montana, has been a high school running champion, a top NCAA runner at the University of Montana, and a USA Track and Field Champion; and

WHEREAS, Scott McGowan has been named a Four-Time All-American track and field athlete; and

WHEREAS, a 4-minute mile has long been regarded as the Gold Standard of middle distance running; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2005, Scott McGowan ran the Reebok Boston Indoor Games Mile in Boston, Massachusetts, in 3 minutes, 58.91 seconds, becoming the first Montana native to break the 4-minute mile.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That Scott McGowan of Poplar, Montana, is hereby officially recognized by the Montana Legislature and the Governor for his outstanding athletic achievement in becoming Montana's first "Sub-4 Minute Miler."
