HOUSE BILL NO. 437 INTRODUCED BY D. GALLIK

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO INCLUDE A DISPUTE RESOLUTION CLAUSE IN ITS CONTRACTS WITH THIRD-PARTY PROVIDERS OF HUMAN SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Dispute resolution requirement for contracts. Each contract or agreement for human services that the department of public health and human services enters into with a third-party provider of services must contain a clause requiring dispute resolution in the event of a disagreement between the provider and the department about the terms of the contract or agreement EACH WRITTEN CONTRACT THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ENTERS INTO FOR THE PROVISION OF HUMAN SERVICES TO A THIRD PARTY MUST CONTAIN A CLAUSE PROVIDING FOR A DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF DISAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CONTRACTOR AND THE DEPARTMENT ABOUT THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 2, chapter 15, part 22, and the provisions of Title 2, chapter 15, part 22, apply to [section 1].

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2007.
