## HOUSE BILL NO. 478 INTRODUCED BY H. RASER

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CLARIFYING TUITION PAYMENTS FOR HOMELESS CHILDREN; AMENDING SECTION 20-5-101, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 20-5-101, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-5-101. Admittance of child to school. (1) The trustees shall assign and admit a child to a school in the district when the child is:

- (a) 6 years of age or older on or before September 10 of the year in which the child is to enroll but is not yet 19 years of age;
  - (b) a resident of the district; and
  - (c) otherwise qualified under the provisions of this title to be admitted to the school.
- (2) The trustees of a district may assign and admit any nonresident child to a school in the district under the tuition provisions of this title.
- (3) The trustees may at their discretion assign and admit a child to a school in the district who is under 6 years of age or an adult who is 19 years of age or older if there are exceptional circumstances that merit waiving the age provision of this section.
- (4) The trustees shall assign and admit a child who is homeless, as defined in the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act (Public Law 100-77), to a school in the district regardless of residence. The trustees may not require an out-of-district attendance agreement or tuition for a homeless child. However, the office of public instruction shall pay tuition for reported students pursuant to 20-5-324(2).
- (5) Except for the provisions of subsection (4), tuition for a nonresident child must be paid in accordance with the tuition provisions of this title."

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
