BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROCUREMENT REBATE SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNT; PROVIDING FOR THE FUNDING AND USE OF MONEY IN THE ACCOUNT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 1. Procurement rebate account -- funding -- use.** (1) There is an account in the state special revenue fund established by 17-2-102 to be known as the procurement rebate special revenue account.

- (2) All rebates collected from using state procurement cards and contracts must be deposited in the procurement rebate special revenue account.
 - (3) The money in the account may be used only to:
 - (a) administer the state's procurement card programs; and
- (b) administer procurement-related activities, including procurement-related litigation, recycling of electronics, and surplus property management.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 18, chapter 4, part 2, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter 4, part 2, apply to [section 1].

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2007.
