

SENATE BILL NO. 208
INTRODUCED BY M. TROPILA

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INSTRUCTING MOTORISTS TO MAKE A COMPLETE STOP, AS IF AT A STOP SIGN, WHEN A TRAFFIC LIGHT IS INOPERATIVE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Inoperable traffic control device.** An operator of a vehicle approaching an intersection in which an electronic traffic control device is inoperative shall stop in the manner prescribed in 61-8-344, except when directed to proceed by a police officer, highway patrol officer, or traffic control signal.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61, chapter 8, part 2, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 8, part 2, apply to [section 1].
