SENATE BILL NO. 347 INTRODUCED BY J. SHOCKLEY

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO INITIATE, JOIN, OR INTERVENE IN A CONSERVATION EASEMENT ENFORCEMENT ACTION; AMENDING SECTION 76-6-211, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 76-6-211, MCA, is amended to read:

"76-6-211. Who may enforce easement. (1) The owner of any estate in a dominant tenement or the occupant of such that tenement may maintain an action for the enforcement of an easement attached thereto to the tenement.

- (2) Public bodies holding conservation easements shall enforce the provisions of these those easements.
- (3) The attorney general may initiate, join, or intervene in a conservation easement enforcement action if the attorney general REASONABLY determines that:
 - (a) there is a violation or threatened violation of specific conservation easement terms; and
- (b) the easement holder is not protecting the public interest by failing to enforce the terms of a conservation easement; AND
 - (C) THE EASEMENT HOLDER FAILS TO FULFILL THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 76, CHAPTER 6."

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
