Dear Speaker Milburn and President Peterson:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, I hereby return with amendments House Bill 416, "**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE ACTIVITIES BY MEDICAL PRACTICE GROUPS; PROVIDING FOR CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF QUALITY ASSURANCE COMMITTEES; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.**"

House Bill 416 authorizes medical practice groups of two or more practitioners to establish quality assurance programs to review pending medical malpractice claims, conduct risk management activities, and undertake quality assurance reviews of individual cases or general practices. Perhaps the most prominent feature of the legislation is that it assures confidentiality of the matters discussed and considered by a quality assurance committee.

My concern with the legislation is that I believe its confidentiality provisions extend too far in one particular. The legislation, as written, appears to allow *facts* about a medical treatment to be withheld from a patient if the facts do not appear in an "incident report or occurrence report," but are disclosed in the context of the quality assurance committee proceedings. Certainly, the *facts* about the medical care provided to an individual should not be withheld from that individual –

regardless of where those facts come to light, i.e., in the patient's medical chart or in the discussions of a quality assurance committee proceeding.

My amendment assures that a patient will always have access to the facts about the care the patient received. In keeping with the bill's overall intent, the amendment continues to assure that the mental impressions, conclusions, opinions, or theories about the treatment of a patient, when discussed by the quality assurance committee, will stand protected as confidential, thereby serving the ultimate goal of quality assurance programs – to provide the best quality medical care of patients.

I ask you for favorable consideration of my proposed amendment to HB 416. " for the following reasons.

Dear Speaker Milburn and President Peterson:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, I hereby return with amendments House Bill 59, "**AN ACT REVISING THE DEFINITION OF "ELIGIBLE RENEWABLE RESOURCE" TO INCLUDE HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT EXPANSIONS; GRANTING THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION RULEMAKING AUTHORITY OVER HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT EXPANSIONS; AMENDING SECTIONS 69-3-2003 AND 69-3-2006, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE**" for the following reasons.

House Bill 59 amends Montana's Renewable Power Production and Rural Economic Development Act, passed by the 2005 Legislature and which I signed into law, by allowing expansion of generation capacity at existing hydro projects to be incorporated into Montana's Renewable Portfolio Standard. By and large, the amendments to the Act contained in HB 59 are consistent with the Act's original purpose, which was to create incentives for diverse rural economic development through the production of renewable power commencing operation after January 1, 2005.

The bill has one problem, which my amendments propose to resolve. As written, HB 59 would apply to at least one project that is already underway. Allowing the incentives under the Act to apply retroactively to a project already underway creates no new jobs, and therefore does not serve either the Act's original purpose – to expand rural economic development – or my top legislative priority this session – to create new jobs. I know many legislators have expressed this priority, as well.

I believe most Montanans see the benefit of incentives that apply in a forward-looking manner to create jobs. I do not believe these same Montanans support giving an after-the-fact reward to a company for a project the company already commenced. My amendments limit the bill's applicability to projects that commence construction after the effective date of HB 59.

Hydropower is welcomed by Montanans, and it is welcomed by our current RPS statute. I believe HB 59, amended as I propose, allows for incremental hydro projects while still meeting the intent of the original Act.
