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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Section 15-30-2522, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"15-30-2522. Withholding of lottery winnings. (1) When making any payment of winnings that are
13	subject to withholding, the state lottery commission, created under Title 23, chapter 7, part 2, shall deduct and
14	withhold from the payment a tax in an amount equal to $\frac{10\%}{6.9\%}$ of the payment.
15	(2) For the purposes of this section, the phrase "winnings that are subject to withholding" means the
16	proceeds in excess of \$5,000 won from a lottery game operated pursuant to Title 23, chapter 7.
17	(3) Every person who receives a payment of winnings that are subject to withholding shall furnish the
18	state lottery commission with a signed statement containing the name, address, and taxpayer identification
19	number of the recipient and of every person entitled to any portion of the payment. The signed statement must
20	be treated as a statement under oath or equivalent affirmation for the purposes of 45-7-202, relating to the
21	criminal offense of false swearing."
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23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
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25	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Retroactive applicability. [This act] applies retroactively, within the
26	meaning of 1-2-109, to tax years beginning after December 31, 2010.
