9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 13-25-203, MCA, is amended to read:		
12	"13-25-203. Vacancy in office of <u>United States senator or</u> United States representative. (1) If a		
13	vacancy occurs in the office of United States senator or United States representative, the governor shall		
14	immediately order an election to be held to fill the vacancy, except as provided in subsection (3).		
15	(2) The election to fill the unexpired term must be held no less than 85 or more than 100 days from the		
16	date on which the vacancy occurs, except that if the vacancy occurs 150 days or less before a primary election		
17	or between the primary and general elections in odd-numbered years, the election must be held with the primary		
18	or general election.		
19	(3) If the vacancy occurs between the primary and general election in even-numbered years, the		
20	candidate elected to the office for the succeeding full term shall immediately take office to fill the unexpired term."

22	Section 2. Section 13-25-205, MCA, is amended to read:		
23	"13-25-205. Nominations for special election. (1) When a special election is ordered to fill a vacancy		
24	in the office of United States senator or United States representative, each political party shall choose a candidate		
25	according to the rules of the party. Nominations by parties must be made no later than 85 days before the date		
26	set for the election.		
27	(2) Nominating petitions may be filed by independent candidates for the office up to 5 p.m. of the 85th		
28	day before the election."
