8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 2-15-1821, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"2-15-1821. Coal board allocation composition. (1) There is a coal board composed of seven
12	members.
13	(2) The coal board is allocated to the department of commerce for administrative purposes only as
14	prescribed in 2-15-121.
15	(3) The governor shall appoint a seven-member coal board, as provided under 2-15-124.
16	(4) (a) Subject to subsections (4)(b) and (4)(c), <u>through (4)(d)</u> <u>AND (4)(C),</u> the members of the coal board
17	are selected as follows:
18	(i) two FOUR from the impact areas; and
19	(ii) two with expertise in education.
20	(b) At least two but not more than four members must be appointed from each district provided for in
21	5-1-102.
22	(c) In making the appointments, the governor shall consider people from the following fields:
23	(i) business;
24	(ii) engineering;
25	(iii) LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR public administration; and
26	(iv) planning.
27	(d) At least one member appointed in accordance with subsection (4)(a)(i) must be from an incorporated
28	city or town with a population of 50,000 or more according to the most recent federal census or estimate."

30	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
