10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	
12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Sudden change in bed of navigable river or stream. (1) If a navigable
13	river or stream rapidly abandons its channel and forms a new river or stream channel, the land that constituted
14	the old channel belongs to the owner of the shores through which the old channel flowed or, if the shores are
15	owned by different owners, to the owners of the shore on the two sides, divided by an imaginary line drawn
16	through the middle of the old river or stream channel. The land that constituted the old channel is subject to
17	property taxation payable by the new owners.
18	(2) Ownership remains unchanged for land that constituted an island before the change AVULSION
19	OCCURRED in THE channel and that is not an island WHOLLY SURROUNDED BY WATER after the river has abandoned
20	the old channel.
21	(3) As a channel of a navigable river or stream, the land under the water of the new channel belongs to
22	the state pursuant to 70-1-202.
23	(4) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "NAVIGABLE" MEANS A RIVER OR STREAM ADJUDICATED AS NAVIGABLE
24	FOR TITLE PURPOSES BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION.

26	Section 2. Section 77-1-102, MCA, is amended to read:
27	"77-1-102. Ownership of certain islands and abandoned riverbeds. (1) All Except as provided in
28	[section 1] and subsection (2) of this section AND SUBJECT TO TITLE 70, CHAPTER 18, PART 2, the following lands
29	belong to the state of Montana to be held in trust for the benefit of the public schools of the state:
30	(a) all lands lying and being in and forming a part of the abandoned bed of any navigable stream or lake

in this state and lying between the meandered lines of such the stream or lake as the same are shown by the 2 United States survey thereof and of the lands; and 3 (b) all islands existing in the navigable streams or lakes in this state which that have not been surveyed by the government of the United States and all lands which that at any time in the past comprised such were an 4 5 island or any part thereof, of the island. 6 (2) This section does not apply to except such lands as that are occupied by and belong to the adjacent 7 landowners as that were formed by accretions, belong to the state of Montana to be held in trust for the benefit 8 of the public schools of the state. 9 (3) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION: 10 (A) "ABANDONED BED" MEANS A RIVER BED OR STREAM BED WITH NO WATER OVER IT; AND 11 (B) "NAVIGABLE" MEANS A RIVER OR STREAM ADJUDICATED AS NAVIGABLE FOR TITLE PURPOSES BY A COURT OF 12 COMPETENT JURISDICTION." 13 14 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Repealer. The following section of the Montana Code Annotated is 15 REPEALED: 16 70-18-202. SUDDEN REMOVAL OF BANK -- RIGHT OF OWNER TO RECLAIM. 17 18 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an 19 integral part of Title 70, chapter 18, part 2, and the provisions of Title 70, chapter 18, part 2, apply to [section 1]. 20 21 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Applicability. [This act] applies to a sudden change in the bed of a 22 navigable river or stream that occurs on or after October 1, 2011. 23 - END -
