Dear Speaker Blasdel and President Essmann,

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, I hereby veto HB 18, "AN ACT CLARIFYING THE DISTRIBUTIONS AND AMOUNTS TO BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE STATE GENERAL FUND TO THE RESEARCH AND COMMERCIALIZATION STATE SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNT; AMENDING SECTIONS 7-14-112, 10-2-112, 10-2-603, 10-3-801, 15-1-122, AND 15-35-108, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

HB 18 was introduced at the recommendation of the Legislative Finance Committee to clarify the distribution mechanism for fund transfers from the general fund to the research and commercialization state special revenue account. HB 18 is an internal accounting fix that does not change the statutory appropriation to the research and commercialization state special revenue account. This technical fix unfortunately creates a conflict with HB 454 which will use spendable interest from the Permanent Fund of the Coal Tax Trust to help offset the costs of local governments. The Board of Research and Commercialization plays an important role in ensuring that work done at the Montana University System can translate into the market place, which is why I've proposed maintaining present law funding for the board in my Executive Budget.

As outlined in the budget I submitted to the Legislature, I believe we have an obligation to address our long-term liabilities and honor the promises made by our predecessors. This obligation includes fixing our retirement systems. HB 454, which is supported by a broad coalition including public employers and employees from across Montana, will temporarily increase employee and employer contributions to the public employee retiree system until the system is determined to be actuarially sound. It utilizes some of the spendable interest from the Permanent Fund of the Coal Tax Trust, coal severance tax revenues and state land revenues to assist local governments in meeting their financial obligations. Article VIII, section 15 of the Montana Constitution compels us to act, and HB 454 provides a comprehensive solution of shared sacrifice to shore up our public employee retirement system without raising taxes.

Because HB 18 interferes with the comprehensive proposal to bring our retirement systems back to sound actuarial footing, I respectfully request that you sustain my veto.
