10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 2-15-142, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"2-15-142. Guiding principles. In formulating or implementing policies or administrative rules that have
14	direct tribal implications, a state agency should consider shall document its consideration of the following
15	principles:
16	(1) a commitment to cooperation and collaboration;
17	(2) mutual understanding and respect;
18	(3) regular and early communication;
19	(4) a process of accountability for addressing issues; and
20	(5) preservation of the tribal-state relationship."
21	
22	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a
23	copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shell
24	Chippewa tribe.
