| 13 | Section 1. Section 75-10-115, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 14 | "75-10-115. Solid waste management fee. (1) The department may prepare rules for adoption by the |
| 15 | board, pursuant to 75-10-104 and 75-10-106, that set fees for the management and regulation of solid waste at |
| 16 | facilities subject to regulation pursuant to part 2 of this chapter. Upon adoption by the board, the department may |
| 17 | collect the fees. These fees may include: |
| 18 | (a) except as provided in subsection (2)(b), a license application fee that reflects the cost of reviewing |
| 19 | a new solid waste management system or a substantial change to an existing facility; from the time an application |
| 20 | is made through the time conditions attached to an application are approved by the department. The department |
| 21 | shall also provide a justification for review costs if requested by an applicant. |
| 22 | (b) except as provided in subsection (2)(a), a flat annual license renewal fee that reflects a minimal base |
| 23 | fee related to the fixed costs of an annual inspection and license renewal and that is based upon the |
| 24 | categorization of solid waste management systems into separate classes identified by the following criteria: |
| 25 | (i) the quantity of solid waste received by the solid waste management system; |
| 26 | (ii) the nature of the solid waste received; and |
| 27 | (iii) the nature of the waste management occurring within the solid waste management system; and |
| 28 | (c) a tonnage or volume-based fee on solid waste disposal. |
| 29 | (2) (a) An annual license renewal fee may not be collected until a solid waste management system |
| 30 | receives solid waste. |

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| 1 | (b) The department may not increase license application fees to offset the prohibition provided for in |
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| 2 | subsection (2)(a). |
| 3 | (2)(3) All fees collected must be deposited in the solid waste management account provided for in |
| 4 | 75-10-117." |
