8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 25-31-112, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"25-31-112. Fees. The following is the schedule of fees which that, except as provided in 25-35-605,
12	shall must be paid in every civil action in a justice's court:
13	(1) $\$25$ $\$50$ when a complaint is filed, to be paid by the plaintiff; WHEN A COMPLAINT IS FILED, THE
14	FOLLOWING FEE TO BE PAID BY THE PLAINTIFF:
15	(A) \$30 IN BEGINNING JULY 1, 2013;
16	(B) \$35 IN BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014; AND
17	(c) \$40 in beginning July 1, 2015 and subsequent years;
18	(D) \$45 IN 2016; AND
19	(E) \$50 IN 2017 AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS;
20	(2) \$10 \$20 when the defendant appears, to be paid by the defendant;
21	(3) \$10 \$20 to be paid by the prevailing party when judgment is rendered. IN CASES IN WHICH JUDGMENT
22	IS ENTERED BY DEFAULT, NO CHARGE EXCEPT THE FEE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1) FOR THE FILING OF THE COMPLAINT
23	MAY BE MADE FOR ANY SERVICES, INCLUDING ISSUING AND RETURN OF EXECUTION. In cases where in which judgment
24	is entered by default, no charge except the \$25 FEE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1) for the filing of the complaint shall
25	may be made for any services, including issuing and return of execution.
26	(4) \$10 \$20 for all services in an action where in which judgment is rendered by confession;
27	(5) $\$10$ $\$20$ for filing <u>a</u> notice of appeal and transcript on appeal, justifying and approving <u>an</u> undertaking
28	on appeal, and transmitting papers to the district court with \underline{a} certificate."

30	Section 2. Section 25-35-608, MCA, is amended to read:

1	"25-35-608. Fees. (1) The clerk of the justice's court shall collect a fee of:
2	(a) \$10 \$20 from the plaintiff upon the filing of the sworn complaint; and
3	(b) \$5 \$10 from the defendant upon the defendant's appearance and contesting of the complaint of
4	execution of a counterclaim.
5	(2) The laws relating to paupers' affidavits apply to actions before the small claims court."
