10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Display of POW/MIA flag. (1) The POW/MIA flag must be displayed on									
13	or in front of the locations specified in subsection (2) on any day when the flag of the United States of America									
14	is displayed. The display of the POW/MIA flag is to symbolize Montana's concern and commitment to achieve									
15	the fullest possible accounting of United States military personnel who, having been prisoners of war or missing									
16	in action, still remain unaccounted for or who in the future may become prisoners of war, missing in action, or									
17	otherwise unaccounted for as a result of hostile action.									
18	(2) The POW/MIA flag must be displayed pursuant to subsection (1) at the following locations:									
19	(a) the state capitol;									
20	(b) any building that serves as the location of a state district court;									
21	(c) any building that serves as the location of a city or town hall for an incorporated city or town; and									
22	(d) any building that serves as the main administrative building of a county.									
23	(3) The POW/MIA flag may be no larger than the national flag and must be displayed as follows:									
24	(a) if the national and the POW/MIA flags are flown on the same flag pole, the POW/MIA flag must be									
25	directly below the national flag;									
26	(b) if the national and state flags are flown on the same flag pole, the POW/MIA flag must be directly									
27	below the national flag;									
28	(c) if the national and state flags are flown on two different flag poles, the POW/MIA flag must be on the									
29	pole with and directly below the national flag;									
30	(d) if the national and POW/MIA flags are flown on separate flag poles, the POW/MIA flag must occupy

(e) if the national, state, and POW/MIA flags are to be flown on three separate flag poles, the national flag must occupy the right pole, the POW/MIA flag must occupy the middle pole, and the state flag must occupy the far left pole.

(4) As used in this section, "POW/MIA flag" means the flag designated in 36 U.S.C 902 as the symbol of concern about United States military personnel taken as prisoners of war or listed as missing in action.
