8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Disclaimer on election materials funded by anonymous donors. If a
11	political committee claims to be exempt from disclosing the name of a person making a contribution to the political
12	committee, the committee shall clearly and conspicuously include in all communications advocating the success
13	or defeat of a candidate, political party, or ballot issue through any broadcasting station, newspaper, magazine,
14	outdoor advertising facility, direct mailing, poster, handbill, bumper sticker, internet website, or other form of
15	general political advertising or issue advocacy the following disclaimer: "This communication has been 15 funded
16	by anonymous sources. It is the responsibility of the <u>THE</u> voter to <u>SHOULD</u> determine the veracity of the statements
17	being made and the true character of the organization behind this communication ITS CONTENT."

19	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
20	integral part of Title 13, chapter 35, part 2, and the provisions of Title 13, chapter 35, part 2, apply to [section 1].
