| 10 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Motor carrier transportation contract indemnification limitation. (1)                       |
| 11 | Except as provided in subsection (2), a motor carrier transportation contract provision that requires one party to  |
| 12 | the contract to indemnify, hold harmless, insure, or defend the other party to the contract or the other party's    |
| 13 | officers, employees, or agents for liability, damages, losses, or costs that are caused by the negligence           |
| 14 | recklessness, or intentional misconduct of the other party or the other party's officers, employees, or agents is   |
| 15 | void as against the public policy of this state.  |
| 16 | (2) A motor carrier transportation contract may contain a provision requiring one party to the contract to          |
| 17 | indemnify, hold harmless, or insure the other party to the contract or the other party's officers, employees, or    |
| 18 | agents for liability, damages, losses, or costs, including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees, only to the |
| 19 | extent that the liability, damages, losses, or costs are caused by the negligence, recklessness, or intentional     |
| 20 | misconduct of a third party or of the indemnifying party or the indemnifying party's officers, employees, or agents |
| 21 | (3) This section does not apply to the Uniform Intermodal Interchange and Facilities Access Agreement               |
| 22 | administered by the intermodal association of North America or other agreements providing for the interchange       |
| 23 | use, or possession of intermodal chassis or containers or other intermodal equipment.                               |
| 24 | (4) As used in this section, the following definitions apply:   |
| 25 | (a) "Motor carrier" has the meaning provided in 61-1-101.   |
| 26 | (b) "Motor carrier transportation contract" means a contract, agreement, or understanding covering:                 |
| 27 | (i) the transportation of property for compensation or hire by a motor carrier;                                     |
| 28 | (ii) entrance onto a property by a motor carrier for the purpose of loading, unloading, or transporting             |
| 29 | property for compensation or hire; or   |
| 30 | (iii) a service incidental to an activity described in subsection (4)(a) or (4)(b), including but not limited to    |
