10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Legislative findings legislator standing and intervention in legal
13	challenges authorized. (1) The legislature finds that:
14	(a) proper interpretation and administration of the constitution and legislative enactments and
15	referendums of the state of Montana are matters of great public interest and significant importance; and
16	(b) individual legislators in their capacity as sponsors or cosponsors of legislation at issue who voted for
17	passage and approval of the legislation have a plain, direct, and adequate interest in maintaining the
18	effectiveness of their votes and have a personal stake in ensuring proper interpretation and administration of the
19	constitution and legislative enactments and referendums that is distinguishable from that of the public generally.
20	(2) Legislators in their capacity as sponsors or cosponsors of legislation at issue who voted for passage
21	and approval of the legislation have standing and may intervene in declaratory judgment actions involving alleged
22	constitutional or statutory violations of Montana law.
23	(3) Nothing in this section supersedes the authority of the attorney general to represent the state of
24	Montana.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
27	integral part of Title 5, and the provisions of Title 5 apply to [section 1].

29	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
