13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Human trafficking hotline creation of poster notice penalty
16	RULEMAKING. (1) (a) The department OF JUSTICE shall create a poster that provides information regarding the
17	national human trafficking resource center hotline. The poster must be at least 8 1/2 inches by 11 inches in size,
18	must include, if available, a quick response code that is provided by the national human trafficking resource
19	center for access by mobile devices, and must include the following statement:
20	"If you or someone you know is being forced to engage in any activity and cannot leavewhether it is
21	commercial sex, housework, farm work, or any other activitycall the National Human Trafficking Resource
22	Center Hotline at 1-888-373-7888 to access help and services.
23	Victims of human trafficking are protected under U.S. and Montana law.
24	The toll-free hotline is:
25	- Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week;
26	- Toll-free;
27	- Operated by a nonprofit, nongovernmental organization;
28	- Anonymous and confidential;
29	- Accessible in 170 languages; and
30	- Able to provide help, referral to services, training, and general information."

1	(b) The statement provided in subsection (1)(a) must appear on each poster in English, Spanish, and
2	any other language that is required for voting materials under the federal Voting Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. 1973aa-1a.
3	(2) (a) The department <u>OF JUSTICE</u> shall provide <del>a licensee described in subsection (3) with notice of this</del>
4	section and, upon request of a licensee, a copy of the poster TO PERSONS AND ENTITIES THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF
5	JUSTICE DETERMINES BY RULE SHOULD RECEIVE THE POSTER.
6	(b) The department shall make a copy of the poster available for print on its website.
7	(3) Any licensee under Title 16 that sells or serves alcoholic beverages to the public shall $\underline{THE}$
8	DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE SHALL REQUEST THAT ANY PERSON OR ENTITY RECEIVING A COPY OF THE POSTER display the
9	poster in a location that is accessible to employees and members of the public.
10	(4) A licensee that violates the provisions of subsection (3) is subject to the penalties provided in
11	<del>16-4-406.</del>
12	
13	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Human trafficking hotline posted notice required at rest areas. The
14	department of transportation shall display at each rest area within the limits of the right-of-way of interstate
15	highways and other state highways a poster created by the department of revenue JUSTICE pursuant to [section
16	1] that provides information regarding the national human trafficking resource center hotline.
17	
18	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. (1) [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
19	integral part of Title 16 44, chapter 4, and the provisions of Title 16 44, chapter 4, apply to [section 1].
20	(2) [Section 2] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 60, chapter 2, part 2, and the
21	provisions of Title 60, chapter 2, part 2, apply to [section 2].
