4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA REQUESTING AN INTERIM STUDY TO INVESTIGATE COMPENSATION EQUITY WITHIN
6	MONTANA PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS; AND REQUIRING THAT THE FINAL RESULTS OF THE
7	STUDY BE REPORTED TO THE 64TH LEGISLATURE.
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9	WHEREAS, public education constitutes a large portion of Montana's economy; and
10	WHEREAS, educational institutions impact every community in our state; and
11	WHEREAS, issues of salary inequity can negatively impact overall morale and student performance; and
12	WHEREAS, salary inequity impacts families, communities, and the entire state economy; and
13	WHEREAS, the Legislature has ultimate budgetary oversight over public education institutions in the state
14	of Montana.
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16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
17	STATE OF MONTANA:
18	That the Legislative Council be requested to designate an appropriate interim committee or statutory
19	committee, pursuant to section 5-5-217, MCA, or direct sufficient staff resources to:
20	(1) examine the compensation systems utilized by school districts, tribal colleges, and the Montana
21	University System;
22	(2) explore complaints of salary inequity at Montana public education institutions;
23	(3) examine efforts in other states to ensure equitable compensation systems in public education
24	institutions;
25	(4) identify areas in which Montana public education compensation systems might be made more
26	equitable; and
27	(5) develop for consideration by the 64th Legislature a plan to address any identified issues or problems
28	with Montana public education compensation systems.
29	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be
30	presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.

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- 1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review 2 requirements, be concluded prior to September 15, 2014.
- 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the final results of the study, including any findings, conclusions,
- 4 comments, or recommendations, be reported to the 64th Legislature.
