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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Section 10-3-312, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"10-3-312. Maximum expenditure by governor appropriation. (1) Whenever a disaster or an
13	emergency, including an energy emergency as defined in 90-4-302 or an invasive species emergency declared
14	under 80-7-1013, is declared by the governor, there is statutorily appropriated to the office of the governor, as
15	provided in 17-7-502, and, subject to subsection (2), the governor is authorized to expend from the general fund
16	an amount not to exceed \$16 million in any biennium, minus any amount appropriated pursuant to 10-3-310 in
17	the same biennium. The statutory appropriation in this subsection may be used by any state agency designated
18	by the governor.
19	(2) In the event of the recovery of money expended under this section, the spending authority must be
20	reinstated to a level reflecting the recovery.
21	(3) If a disaster is declared by the president of the United States, there is statutorily appropriated to the
22	office of the governor, as provided in 17-7-502, and the governor is authorized to expend from the general fund
23	an amount not to exceed \$500,000 during the biennium to meet the state's share of the individual individuals and
24	family households grant programs as provided in 42 U.S.C. 5178 5174. The statutory appropriation in this
25	subsection may be used by any state agency designated by the governor."
