2	INTRODUCED BY A. WITTICH

4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES AND UNITS IN THE
5	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM TO REPORT THE AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FUNDS RECEIVED ANNUALLY;
6	REQUIRING THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF BUDGET AND PROGRAM PLANNING TO COMPILE THE
7	REPORTS AND SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE; TO THE LEGISLATURE IF FEDERAL GRANTS
8	AWARDED ARE NOT AT LEAST 90% OF THE AMOUNT ANTICIPATED AND WITH CONTINGENCY PLANS IF
9	ANTICIPATED FEDERAL FUNDS ARE REDUCED; AMENDING SECTION 17-3-102, MCA; AND PROVIDING
10	AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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14	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Short title. [Sections 1 through 3] may be cited as the "Federal Receipts
15	Reporting Requirements Act".
16	
17	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Definitions. As used in [sections 1 through 3], unless the context otherwise
18	requires, the following definitions apply:
19	(1) (a) "Agency" has the meaning provided in 2-15-102.
20	(b) The term does not include either the judicial branch or the legislative branch or any office or entity
21	within either branch.
22	(2) (a) "Federal receipts" means the federal financial assistance that an agency or university system unit
23	receives or administers in the form of grants, loans, loan guarantees, property, cooperative agreements, interest
24	subsidies, insurance, food commodities, direct appropriations, or other assistance.
25	(b) The term does not include amounts received as reimbursement for services rendered to individuals.
26	(3) "University system unit" means a unit within the Montana university system provided for in 20-25-201.
27	
28	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Federal receipts reporting requirements. (1) By July 31 of each year,
29	each agency and university system unit shall submit to the governor's office of budget and program planning a
30	report that:
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1	(a) states the aggregate value of federal receipts that the agency or university system unit received for
2	the preceding fiscal year if the value exceeds \$100,000;
3	(b) states the aggregate amount of federal funds appropriated by the legislature to the agency or
4	university system unit for the preceding fiscal year;
5	(c) calculates the percentage that constitutes federal receipts of the total budget for the agency or
6	university system unit received for that fiscal year; and
7	(d) develops a plan for operating the agency or university system unit if there is a reduction of:
8	(i) 5% or more in the federal receipts that the agency or university system unit receives; and
9	(ii) 25% or more in the federal receipts that the agency or university system unit receives.
10	(2) The governor's office of budget and program planning shall:
11	(a) compile and summarize the reports filed pursuant to subsection (1), including a list of agencies or
12	university system units that failed to submit the required report;
13	(b) compare the aggregate value of federal receipts that each agency or university system unit received
14	for the previous fiscal year to the aggregate amount of federal funds to the total budget of the agency or university
15	system unit for that fiscal year; and
16	(c) submit the results of the requirements of subsections (2)(a) and (2)(b) by September 1 of each year
17	to the legislative finance committee established in 5-12-201.
18	(3) Upon consideration of the report submitted pursuant to subsection (2), the legislative finance
19	committee may:
20	(a) recommend that the legislature reduce or eliminate appropriations for an agency or university system
21	unit;
22	(b) take no action; or
23	(c) take another action approved by a majority of the committee.
24	
25	SECTION 1. SECTION 17-3-102, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
26	"17-3-102. Definitions. As used in this part, the following definitions apply:
27	(1) "Application" means the form specified by a federal agency.
28	(2) "Federal assistance programs" means any financial assistance made to a state agency by an agency
29	of the United States government, whether a grant, loan, gift, contract, or in any other form.
30	(3) "Grantee agency" means any agency of state government receiving federal funds.

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1	(4) "Indirect costs" means costs that benefit more than one agency or program and that are not readily
2	assignable to the agency or program specifically benefiting.
3	(5) "Service agency" means state agencies that provide goods, facilities, and services to a grantee
4	agency.
5	(6) "State agency" means any agency of state government eligible to apply for and receive federal funds.
6	(7) "University system unit" means a unit within the Montana university system provided for in
7	<u>20-25-201.</u> "
8	
9	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Federal reporting requirements. For each federal grant in excess of
10	1 million, each state agency and university system unit shall report in electronic form to the legislative
11	FISCAL DIVISION FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE:
12	(1) WHENEVER GRANTS RECEIVED IN ANY YEAR ARE LESS THAN 90% OF ANTICIPATED AMOUNTS AS
13	APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR THAT YEAR. THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE A SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE IMPACT
14	OF THE DISCREPANCY AND HOW IT WAS ADDRESSED BY THE AGENCY OR UNIVERSITY SYSTEM UNIT.
15	(2) BY OCTOBER 1 OF EACH ODD-NUMBERED FISCAL YEAR, A PLAN FOR OPERATING THE AGENCY OR UNIVERSITY
16	SYSTEM UNIT IF THERE IS A REDUCTION OF 5%, 10%, AND 20% IN THE ANTICIPATED FEDERAL FUNDS THAT THE AGENCY
17	OR UNIVERSITY SYSTEM RECEIVES.

19	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Sections 1 through 3] are [SECTION 2] IS intended
20	to be codified as an integral part of Title 2 17, and the provisions of Title 2 17 apply to [sections 1 through 3]
21	[SECTION 2].

23	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
