7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Option for direct draw by subcontractors. (1) In contracts for a public
10	project, a contracting public agency may agree to follow the payment provisions in subsection (2) or (3) in addition
11	to those in this title, whether or not the contractor furnishes a security as described in 18-2-201.
12	(2) The contracting public agency may, upon a signed agreement with the contractor, allow a direct
13	payment to a subcontractor whose work has been fully accepted by the contracting public agency, regardless
14	of the status of the remainder of the project. This subsection applies to multiple tiers of subcontractors as long
15	as the contractor agrees in writing.
16	(3) The contractor may, without regard to the retainage held by the contracting public agency, provide
17	for a direct draw by a subcontractor if the contractor:
18	(a) after receiving a progress payment, writes a check directly to a subcontractor in exchange for a
19	release against the security described in 18-2-201; or
20	(b) writes a check written directly from the contractor's account to be held by the contracting public
21	agency and provided to the subcontractor upon final acceptance of the work by the contracting public agency and
22	with concurrence of the contractor for the work done by the subcontractor. A check for a subcontractor must be
23	held at the contracting public agency office where the subcontractor may pick up the check in exchange for
24	providing a release against the security.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
27	integral part of Title 18, chapter 2, part 2, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter 2, part 2, apply to [section 1].
