4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING AN 8-YEAR STATUTE OF LIMITATION FOR CAUSES
5	OF ACTION FOR RELIEF ON THE GROUND OF FRAUD OR MISTAKE REGARDING A REFERENDUM,
6	INITIATIVE, OR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT; AND PROVIDING AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	
10	<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Actions challenging validity of referendum, initiative, or constitutional
11	amendment on grounds of fraud or mistake. The period for commencement of an action for relief on the
12	grounds of fraud or mistake regarding a referendum, initiative, or constitutional amendment approved by a vote
13	of the qualified electors of Montana is 8 years. The cause of action does not accrue until the discovery by the
14	aggrieved party of the facts constituting the fraud or mistake.

16	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
17	integral part of Title 13, chapter 27, part 3, and the provisions of Title 13, chapter 27, part 3, apply to [section 1].
18	
19	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to proceedings filed after [the effective date
20	of this act].
