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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Cost of checking illegal immigration status. (1) Each board or the
13	department shall determine the cost of verifying that each applicant for licensure is legally in this country and not
14	an illegal alien as defined in 1-1-411.
15	(2) The cost determination under subsection (1) must be included in an appropriation request by the
16	department to be submitted to each regular session of the legislature, starting with the 63rd legislature.
17	(3) A board or the department on behalf of a department program may not increase licensure fees to
18	implement this section.
19	(4) In addition to using the systematic alien verification for entitlements program provided by the United
20	States department of homeland security or any successor agency, the department may request a notorized copy
21	of a birth certificate or other legal evidence of United States citizenship or lawful alien status.
22	(5) The department may by rule determine which legal evidence of United States citizenship or lawful
23	alien status is to be accepted and whether the information may be electronically delivered.

26	integral part of Title 37, chapter 1, part 1, and the provisions of Title 37, chapter 1, part 1, apply to [section 1].
