7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Limits on chloride-based liquid de-icers. (1) Except as provided in
10	subsections (2) and (3), liquid de-icers containing sodium chloride or magnesium chloride may be used on public
11	highways in Montana between December 1st and March 31st of each year.
12	(2) Chloride-based liquid de-icers may not be used on sections of public highways that are within 1 mile
13	of the Beaverhead, Big Hole, Bighorn, Bitterroot, Clark Fork, Flathead, Kootenai, Madison, Milk, Missouri,
14	Musselshell, Swan, and Yellowstone rivers.
15	(3) The use of chloride-based liquid de-icers on all other public highways or sections of public highways
16	must be reduced from its current level by 25% each year over the 4 years following [the effective date of this act].
17	(4) The provisions of this section do not apply to the use of a 10% rock salt base mixed with sand.

19	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
20	integral part of Title 60, chapter 2, and the provisions of Title 60, chapter 2, apply to [section 1].
