14	licensing boards or other certification entities give due recognition to their extensive military training and the		
15	similarities of that training with professional and occupational licensing requirements or requirements for		
16	certification for other state or local government jobs.

18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY	THE SENATE AND THE F	IOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
19	STATE OF MONTANA:		
20	That the Legislative Council be requested to designate an appropriate interim committee, pursuant to		
21	section 5-5-217, MCA, or direct sufficient staff resources to:		
22	(1) monitor work done by professional and occupational licensing boards regarding recognition of military		
23	training as equivalent to licensing requirements;		
24	(2) identify and examine other certifications or licensing for civilian or state or local government jobs for		
25	which military training and skills may be acceptable equivalents; and		
26	(3) identify statutes, if any, that may need to be amended to allow reciprocity for military training for		
27	licensure or certification.		
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be		
29	presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.		
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review
