FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. The department recognizes that these types of crimes in Montana may increase and could have a future impact. However, there are not sufficient statistics available to determine the number of offenses that may occur. Therefore, the Department of Corrections is unable to determine the fiscal impact from HB 477.
2. If a person is convicted of a felony under this new language, the cost of incarceration is \$34,175 per year per male inmate and \$38,515 per year per female inmate.
