Description of fiscal impact: SB 284 requires authorization of the Board of County Commissioner before wild buffalo or wild bison can be released in a county. The fiscal impact of this bill cannot be determined.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- Neither the Department of Livestock nor the Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks can determine if or when there could request to transplant or relocated wild buffalo or bison in the future.
- The departments cannot determine if a Board of County Commissioners would or would not approve to release, transplant, or relocate such animals in the future.
- The fiscal impact to the state from this bill is unknown.

Secretary of State

- This bill will have minimal cost for postage and administrative duties related to tribal notifications in Section 21 of the bill. The Office of the Secretary of State does not receive general fund monies for office operations, but has agreed to assume the fiscal responsibility for this bill.
