8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Misuse of confidential criminal justice information. (1) A person
11	commits the offense of misuse of confidential criminal justice information if the person is entitled to DIRECTLY
12	access confidential THE criminal justice information NETWORK and purposely or knowingly:
13	(a) accesses confidential criminal justice information for an unauthorized purpose; or
14	(b) disseminates confidential criminal justice information to any person who is not authorized to receive
15	confidential criminal justice information pursuant to 44-5-303.
16	(A) ACCESSES THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION NETWORK FOR PERSONAL USE OR FINANCIAL GAIN; OR
17	(B) DISSEMINATES INFORMATION ACCESSED FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION NETWORK TO ANY
18	PERSON WHO IS NOT AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE CONFIDENTIAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION PURSUANT TO 44-5-303.
19	(2) A person convicted of the offense of misuse of confidential criminal justice information shall be
20	imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months and be fined an amount not less than \$500.
21	(3) For purposes of this section, "confidential criminal justice information" has the meaning provided in
22	44-5-103. THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS APPLY:
23	(A) "CONFIDENTIAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN 44-5-103.
24	(B) "CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION NETWORK" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN 44-2-301.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
27	integral part of Title 45, chapter 7, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 7, apply to [section 1].
