4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING GOVERNMENT ENTITIES FROM ASSISTING
5	FEDERAL AGENCIES IN THE COLLECTION OF ELECTRONIC DATA WITHOUT A WARRANT; AND
6	PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Prohibition on assistance to federal agencies engaged in illegal
11	collection of electronic data or metadata. A government entity may not assist, participate in, or provide material
12	support or resources to enable or facilitate the collection or use by a federal agency of a person's electronic data
13	or metadata without that person's informed consent, without a search warrant based on probable cause that
14	particularly describes the person, place, or thing to be searched or seized, or without acting in accordance with
15	a judicially recognized exception to the warrant requirement.

17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
18	integral part of Title 46, chapter 5, part 1, and the provisions of Title 46, chapter 5, part 1, apply to [section 1].
19	
20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are severable
21	from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of [this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, the part
22	remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
