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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Public and mutual benefit corporations mission statement and
12	accounting report. (1) A public benefit corporation or a foreign corporation designated as a public benefit
13	corporation shall post on its website or, upon demand, make available to a person the following:
14	(a) in less than 60 words, a statement providing the corporation's expected outcomes or results that fulfill
15	the corporation's public benefit; and
16	(b) a report for the prior budget year that includes a detailed list of the corporation's expenditures using
17	generally accepted accounting principles.
18	(2) The attorney general may bring a civil action to compel a corporation to comply with the provisions
19	of this section. The court may award reasonable attorney fees and court costs to the prevailing party.
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21	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
22	integral part of Title 35, chapter 2, part 9, and the provisions of Title 35, chapter 2, part 9, apply to [section 1].
