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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

18	Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:
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20	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Inventory of trails and paths maintenance report to legislature.
21	The department of transportation shall:
22	(1) compile an inventory of all multiuse trails or other paths within state-maintained federal-aid highway
23	rights-of-way that are separated from motorized vehicular traffic by open spaces, pavement, markings, or barriers
24	and that are usable for transportation purposes by pedestrians, runners, bicyclists, skaters, equestrians, and other
25	nonmotorized users;
26	(2) develop a plan for maintaining and repairing the trails and other paths described in subsection (1),
27	including estimated costs for maintenance and repair; and
28	(3) provide a report of the inventory and maintenance plan to the revenue and transportation interim
29	committee and to the 65th legislature.
