ADVERSE COMMITTEE REPORT

STATE ADMINISTRATION (Essmann, Chair):

2/6/2015

During the Reports of Standing Committees in the previous day's Floor Session, a Do Not Pass recommendation Committee Report was read (HB 58), also known as an Adverse Committee Report. According to Rule H40-100, a motion to reject Do Not Pass Committee Report may be debated on the floor.

Minority Leader Hunter rose to object to the use of Adverse Committee Reports and made a substitute motion to reject the report. He stated that he believes the Adverse Committee Report rule is unconstitutional, because it requires a 3/5 vote to overturn the "do not pass" recommendation of the committee while our Constitution only requires a simple majority to enact legislation. He quoted Article V of the State Constitution, referred to the State Supreme Court decision in *State ex rel Judge* case, and read from section 518 of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure. He concluded by stating that our Constitution clearly calls for a standard of majority rule in passing legislation, and that the Adverse Committee Report violates that fundamental tenet of our representative democracy.

Representative Essmann rose in support of the Adverse Committee Report stating that it is both Constitutional and follows the Rules of the Montana Legislature Section H40-100. He stated that Article V Section 10 of the Montana Constitution included the following statement "Each house shall choose its officers from among its members, keep a journal, and have rules for its proceedings." He stated that as an equal branch of the government the Supreme Court has no more business inserting itself into our internal proceedings than the Legislature has inserting itself into the internal proceedings of the Montana Supreme Court. Representative Essmann reminded the body that a version of House Rule 40-100 had been adopted under Chairman Vincent in the 1989 Session and no constitutional challenge to the rule has ever been raised.
