ADVERSE COMMITTEE REPORT

STATE ADMINISTRATION (Essmann, Chair): **HB 335**, do not pass. **HB 514**, do not pass.

Minority Leader Hunter rose in Objection to the Adverse Committee Reports on HB 335 and 514. He stated that since Montana became a state the constitutional provisions that govern over the Legislature are the fundamental principles of majority rule. Article 5 Section 11 is specific to this point, as it regards legislation. The Montana Supreme Court recognized and applied this principle that a legislative body cannot constitutionally delegate its power to even a committee of its own

members and a seminal case construing that section in *State ex rel Judge v Legislative Finance Committee*. The Mason Manual of Legislative Procedures which is formally adopted as the underpinning of our own rules also speaks to the fundamental primacy of constitutional principles of majority rules in many sections including Sections 10, 12, 51 and 510. Minority Hunter renewed objections to the use of Rule H40-100, Adverse Committee Reports, requiring a super majority to reject such a report.
