When the trustees canvass the vote of a school district division election under this section, they shall determine the approval or rejection of the division proposition as follows:

(a) Except as provided in subsection (4)(c), if the school district division election is held at a regular school election or at a special election called by the trustees, the trustees shall:

(i) determine the total number of electors of the elementary school district who are qualified to vote under the provisions of 20-20-301 from the list of electors provided by the county registrar for the school district division election;

(ii) determine the total number of qualified electors voting at the school district division election from the tally sheets for the election; and

(iii) calculate the percentage of qualified electors voting at the school district division election by dividing the amount determined in subsection (4)(a)(i) by the amount determined in subsection (4)(a)(i).

(b) When the calculated percentage in subsection (4)(a)(iii) is:

(i) 40% or more, the school district division proposition is approved and adopted only if a majority of the votes were cast in favor of the proposition;

(ii) more than 30% but less than 40%, the school district division proposition is approved and adopted only if 60% or more of the votes were cast in favor of the proposition; or

(iii) 30% or less, the school district division proposition is rejected.

(c) If the school district division election is held at a general election, at an election that is conducted by mail ballot as provided in Title 13, chapter 19, or at a special election that is held in conjunction with a regular or primary election, the determination of the approval or rejection of the school district division proposition is made by a majority of the votes cast on the issue.

(d) If the canvass of the vote establishes the approval and adoption of the school district division proposition, the trustees shall issue a certificate proclaiming the passage of the proposition."
